

Teamwork

This week I am proud to be sharing an exciting example of our teachers immersing themselves in a learning environment, and embracing the opportunity inherent in our school value of Teamwork. As we round out our review and development of a rigorous whole school Writing approach, our teachers are working collaboratively with broader networks to lead work in this area. We are part of a FISO network, consisting of 5 schools all working to

develop and enrich teaching and learning in the area of Writing. FISO stands for "Framework for Improving Student Outcomes", and last Wednesday we hosted all five schools as we analysed research, compared current practice and refined the use of student learning goals to meet the needs of all learners. It was a great

privilege to host this inaugural learning opportunity, which has paved the way for further collaboration in Term Four and beyond.

Thank you

I would like to thank the many families who responded to our Survey Monkey, asking you to share your opinion on the Student Led Conferences (SLC) and our school's Newsletter. I would like to update you on how this has influenced our decisions so far.

We were given a great deal of quality feedback on the booking process for SLC's and as a result, have decided to overhaul our data management system. This work will support a more streamlined approach, eventually replacing our push notification program (Flexibuzz), and our SLC bookings. Importantly, it will facilitate the introduction of online payments and parent permission forms in 2019, as well as SMS notifications for student absences. Other benefits will also be gradually rolled out, with additional functionality added over the following 12 months.

We also appreciate the comments and data provided on our Newsletter, and from today will be moving to a fortnightly publication. Mrs Breeden-Walton and I are working to avoid replication in our articles, while we will continue to use this form of communication to share news and events with the community. It seems that the dates on the first page have also been well received.


As we continue to unpack the information you have provided, I will update you with further refinements as they are made.
