#### **Essential Student Learning Items**

Under DET guidelines, parents are requested to pay for these items. These items are purchased by the school to ensure uniformity of materials across the school and cost efficiency (ex-GST). The school purchases these items for each student in good faith, bearing in mind that parents will recompense the school via this charge. These items include typical booklist items such as stationery; text books; equipment and other items for your child's use across the following curriculum areas: English, Mathematics, Science & Technology, Performing and Visual Arts, eLearning (IT), Physical Education and Sport. The school purchases these materials in bulk, free of GST. Note: Parents may choose to provide or purchase some items themselves. If you choose to do this you must contact the school so that we can provide a list of items required to ensure your child has the correct items. There may be some items or services you cannot purchase yourself.

Category Breakdown: The Essential Education Item charge of \$255 covers the following:

## **Additional School Charges**

Additional school charges may arise during the year and are offered on a user-pay basis. It is expected that there will be several excursions/camps organised throughout the year for all year levels, for example, Melbourne Museum, Scienceworks and middle and senior school camps.

Inter-School Sports 2019 (Levels 5 & 6 only) Costs associated with transport to Inter-school sport. As this is a small weekly expense we ask that parents pay this cost as an annual charge.

With the introduction of Compass we will not be advising an anticipated amount for excursions swimming etc but instead parents will be able to pay as the excursions arise, online (via Compass) as part of providing permission to participate.

## \*Parent Voluntary Contributions - (not tax deductible)

Each year, the school invites voluntary contributions from families for specific purposes such as equipment, materials and services. It is suggested that a voluntary contribution of \$150 per child would facilitate the school to achieve identified strategic planned targets. Voluntary contributions of any amount are greatly appreciated.

# \*Maintenance - (not tax deductible)

The Buildings and Grounds Committee need the support of the school community to assist with the enhancement and maintenance of the school's buildings and grounds, a \$100 (\$50 if attending Working Bee) maintenance contribution per family is sought. This should be included with your remittance.

# \*Building Trust Fund - (tax deductible)

This levy provides funds which enable the School Council to finance small school building projects. The Building Trust Fund is a registered tax deduction. Contributions can vary e.g. \$100 / \$50 / \$25.
